You are instructed to conduct a full field investigation () a preliminary inquiry () concerning the above named individual. This investigation is to be assigned immediately and the results mailed to reach the Bureau by May 12, 1951

This investigation has been requested by the Civil Service Commission, information developed through a confidential inquiry. This was directed to the Fairchild Publications, Boston, Massachusetts, and in reply thereto Wight Martindale advised that his company could not recommend the appointee for instant position. On inquiry, the Commission developed the allegation that the appointee had a definite "pink tinge" and allegedly was pro-Russian in all his thinking and utterances.
