On 7/6/65 the White House requested investigations of captioned individuals, who are apparently being considered for Presidential appointments, positions not stated.

Rear Admiral Karo has been Director of the United States Coast and Geodetic Survey since August, 1955. We conducted a Special Inquiry of him in August, 1955, for the Eisenhower Administration. He is a career employee of the Coast and Geodetic Survey having been employed by that agency since 1923. The investigation was favorable.

White has been Chief of the Weather Bureau, Department of Commerce, since August, 1963. He is a highly regarded meteorologist. We conducted Loyalty of Government Employees investigation of him in 1951 based on an allegation that he possibly had communist sympathies, which allegation investigation did not substantiate. We conducted Special Inquiry of him for the Kennedy Administration in July, 1963, which was favorable.

**ACTION:**

The cases have been ordered separately to the field and the field has been instructed to conduct no neighborhood investigation without Bureau approval. You will be advised of any unusual developments.
