Subject was investigated at the request of the Commerce Department, however, the position of Chief of Weather Bureau for which he was being considered was a presidential appointment and the results were furnished to the White House. During 1951, he was investigated under Executive Order 9835 based on an allegation by one individual that White had "pink tinge." He was found eligible by CSC on loyalty. His brother, Theodore, an author of two best sellers and a Far East correspondent in the 1930's and 40's, was connected with the Institute on Pacific Relations, and affiliated groups. In accordance per instructions, USIA referred to the White House for results of investigations.
