

EPA SECURITY ALERT

DEC 12 1991

At approximately 7:05 p.m. on Wednesday, December 11, 1991, an EPA employee was assaulted at 3rd and K Streets, S.W. The employee was in his car when five males (17 years and up in age) approached the car and threw a brick at the car. The employee was also hit in the head by a brick when he left his car and began chasing his assailants. The employee was not seriously hurt.

Action Taken

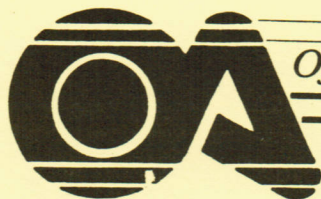
The Metropolitan Police Department responded.

Preventive Measures

- o **DO NOT PARK** your car in the areas of 3rd and K, Canal Street or Delaware Avenue.
- o **DO NOT CHASE** an individual or group into their element -- your life is more important.
- o **DO NOT WALK ALONE** -- consider walking with a companion or group to your destination.
- o Remember that you can bring your car into the EPA garage, even if you are not a member of a carpool, beginning at 4:30 p.m.
- o Change your route or return to the work place if you should feel unsafe by the presence of an individual or group of teenagers.
- o Call out a name of someone nearby (even if you don't know the individual). This will bring attention to yourself and a witness to the situation you are in.

Should you notice suspicious activity outside the building notify the local police on 911 immediately. Notify guard control of incidents that occur in your assigned building.
