Upon consideration of submissions relative to petitioners' motion for a stay of respondent U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's Biological Opinion and Incidental Take Statement, the court grants the motion and stays the Biological Opinion and Incidental Take Statement for the Mountain Valley Pipeline pending a decision by this court on the petition for review.

Upon consideration of submissions relative to respondents' motion to hold litigation in abeyance, the court grants the motion and places this case in abeyance until January 11, 2020, pending completion of re-consultation between the Fish and Wildlife Service and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, without prejudice to petitioners' right to seek further relief if circumstances change materially during the abeyance period. The parties shall file a status report on November 12, 2019, and every 30 days thereafter and shall notify this court immediately if circumstances change materially during the abeyance period
