Right – and that’s over several projects. I’ve heard projections of even less. VW DEIS projects 169 FT jobs during operations phase. My understanding is that very few of those are blue collar.

Essentially, the promise of all these jobs in ports is dependent on near-constant construction of some project or other. Several developers and wind consultants have told me that the labor market is going to be a problem if leasing occurs “in fits and starts.”
